Open (4:1)

1<sup>st</sup> Edworthy's Maycourt Jumpin Jack Flash

Masculine head, balanced with kind eye and expression. Powerful neck leading to well placed shoulders, good depth to forechest and ribs well sprung and back. Firm through loin which meant he held his topline at all times. Well developed quarters giving drive from the rear. Moved true fore and aft and in good coat with tight curl.

Special Yearling (10:2)

1<sup>st</sup> Yeo's Thorncross Cornish Crusade at Trexon

Black and white dog of good overall balance and substance. Pleasing head, still needing to break. Good reach of neck leading to clean shoulders and good upper arm, angles as one should expect for his age, good ribs well back and sprung, in super hard condition and very true on the move, a promising youngster. BPIB Gundog puppy Group 2.

3<sup>rd</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane Black Ice

Graduate (4:1)

1<sup>st</sup> Gordon's Hawkfield Lets Go Crackers

B/W Dog with beautiful head, balanced and correct amount of work and stop, gentle expression. Good reach of neck leading to well placed shoulders and good return of upper arm, strong topline and good tailset. Quarters well developed and bend stifles allowing for a good driving action in profile. In excellent hard condition.

2<sup>nd</sup> Yeo's Trexon Run to the Hills

3<sup>rd</sup> Warford's Hampsbeck Newton's Pride

Open Dog (4)

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane Obe Gold

O/W dog presenting good balance, size and substance, classic head with dark eye and soft expression. Good reach of neck leading to well placed shoulders and good shoulder placement. Good return of upper arm and dept of brisket. Ribs well back and sprung, firm through the loin and held his topline at all times. Developed quarters giving him drive and power on the move, lovely side gait and true fore and aft, beautifully handled.

3<sup>rd</sup> Yeo's Trexon Tick Tack

Open Bitch (3)

1<sup>st</sup> Coggins Medogold Bewitched to Genrose.

Feminine black and white of correct size, lovely head and expression good reach of neck and well placed shoulders. Balanced angles fore and aft. Depth of chest and well sprung ribs. Good finish to the croup and well bent stifles. Moved true but would be improved if in slightly harder condition. Lovely type of bitch.

Puppy (3:1)

1<sup>st</sup> Snook's Manchela Magic Touch

Black and white boy showing good potential, pleasing head, balanced but still needs to finish. Good reach of neck and shoulder placement, well angulated front and rear. Good ribs and short through the loin. Moved true but needs to get a little more confidence, loads of coat for his age.

2<sup>nd</sup> Webb's Clashann Guy Fawkes by Caenriver

Special Yearling (4)

1<sup>st</sup> Green & Brain's Rothmia Queen Sophia at Meloneras

Black bitch with pleasing expression, good front angulation, clean through neck and shoulders, level topline and correct tailset. Ribs well sprung and developed quarters. Moved true with enthusiasm.

2<sup>nd</sup> Burgess' Coakers Unique

3<sup>rd</sup> Partridges Bleujennow Orange Stunner

Post Graduate (7:2)

1<sup>st</sup> Peam's Brelade Miss Tenious

Blue bitch of good size, shape and substance. Feminine balanced head. Good reach of neck and well placed shoulders. Well angulated front and depth to forechest. Ribs well sprung and short through the loin. Stood on good legs and feet with the correct amount of bone. Moved well covering the ground.

2<sup>nd</sup> Colliers Pepperbox Ice Storm

3<sup>rd</sup> Burgess' Coakers Prtige

Open (6)

1<sup>st</sup> Ellisons Withflor Shining

Black bitch with exquisite head and expression, lovely reach of neck and well placed shoulders, super return of upper arm and depth to chest. Ribs well sprung and back, short through the loin and good finish to the croup. Stifles well bent, correct bone and neat feet. In full bloom and moved very well in class and challenge, merrily and covering the ground but unfortunately threw in the towel in the Group. BOB

2<sup>nd</sup> Peam's Totenkopf Rocknrobin with Gwbert SHCM

Another good example of the breed, masculine head with soft expression, good body properties and in good coat, just did not have the sparkle of the bitch on the move. RBOB

3<sup>rd</sup> Colliers Pepperbox Summer Storm

Hungarian Vizsla

Open (2)

1<sup>st</sup> Willcock-Bates' Bournehouse Rainow Sun Over Iscaviz

Male of 2 years and he certainly enjoys showing! Masculine head, super reach of neck, balanced angles fore and aft, ribs well sprung and firm through the loin, good finish to the croup. Moved very well in profile despite giving his handler a hard time and was more positive in front action than 2. BOB

Italian Spinone

Open (2)

1<sup>st</sup> Smiths Kevardhu Caswyn SHCM

Very nicely balanced Orange dog, full of substance yet moved effortlessly around the ring. Most appealing head and expression and eye, balanced planes. Powerful neck leading well into shoulders. Well angulated front assembly and deep through the forechest. Ribs well sprung and firm through the loin. Powerful quarters allowing for drive on the move. Correct topline and well set on tail, thick skin and in good coat. BOB

Group 3

2<sup>nd</sup> Longstaff's Kevardhu Pokkyl SHCM

Weimaraner

Post Graduate (3:2)

1<sup>st</sup> Wales Greycharm Giggles

Bitch of good overall shape and balance, feminine head and expression, good reach of neck and well placed shoulders, good front and rear angulation, ribs well sprung and firm through the loin. Developed quarters which were used to advantage on the move. Preferred the overall height to length ratio to my BOB but not at one with her handler and it made it difficult to assess her on the move.

Open (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Jones' Khamssynn Canasta

Bitch with a beautifully balanced head with soft and inelegant expression. Good reach of neck which was powerful and lead smoothly into well placed shoulders, good return of upper arm and depth to brisket. Ribs sprung and well back, a little long through loin but maintained her topline at all times. Quarters well developed and moved very well indeed, super rapport between dog and handler. BOB

Welsh Springer Spaniel

Graduate (3:1)

1<sup>st</sup> Baguley & Attwood's Kylowen Gerrans

Masculine head, powerful neck, strong topline and super quarters. Balanced angles both front and rear, ribs well back and firm loin, coat of good colour and texture, held himself well on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Attwood's Kylowen Quillets

Open (5)

1<sup>st</sup> Barnes Islemoor Ruby Tuesday with Barhi SHCM

Bitch of good overall shape and substance. Feminine head with well placed ears. Good neck and clean into shoulders. Well angulated front assembly, deep chest and ribs well

back and sprung. Firm through loin and quarters. Well bent stifles and good bone and feet. Moved well and sympathetically handled.

2<sup>nd</sup> Shears Glanffrywd Westward Boy at Glenkerry

3<sup>rd</sup> Baguley & Crowthers Tannamoor Hallmark at Lligwy SHCM

AVNSC Gundog Open (4:1)

1<sup>st</sup> Marsh's Fielgar Majestic Eclipse

Black American Cocker, Very nice head with correct balance, stop and finish to the flew. Low set ears, super clean reach of neck leading to good front assembly. Ribs well sprung and firm through the loin. Developed quarters which enabled him to drive around the ring. Held topline at all times, well presented in full coat. Best AVNSC Gundog Group 2

2<sup>nd</sup> Branney's Tarndair Pheonix (H W/H Viz)

3<sup>rd</sup> Sheppard's Kyssmeo Trick or Treat with Shadowview (Am Cocker)

AV Gundog Puppy (5:2)

1<sup>st</sup> Caile's Bliztan Eternal Treasure (Large Munsterlander)

Feminine head with kind eye and expression, good reach of neck and clean over the shoulders. Front and rear angulation correct for her age, good rib and firm through loin, held topline and stood on good legs and feet. Moved ok but needs to settle but this should come with age.

2<sup>nd</sup> Sheppard's Kyssmeo Angel Kisses for Shadowview

AV Gundog Veteran (13:6)

1<sup>st</sup> Dyke's Briator Laura's Song ShCM (English Setter)

Blue bitch of 10 years, Good overall balance and presented a clean outline. Feminine head and kind expression, good reach of neck and clean over the shoulders. Well angulated front and deep through chest, well sprung rib and firm through the loin, stifles well bent and lovely tailset and action. Moved very well in profile.

2<sup>nd</sup> Barnes Sh Ch Barhi Crouching Tiger (WSS)

Very good example of the breed, all male without coarseness, Masculine head with kind eye and expression, good neck and front angulation. Ribs sprung and firm through the loin to well developed quarters. Carrying a little too much weight which spoils his outline today.

3<sup>rd</sup> Pike's Redclyst Glenury Countess.

Gundog Group

1<sup>st</sup> Hall's Glennara Lehana (Irish Setter)

Beautiful feminine example of the breed and a favourite of mine. Feminine head with raised brow and gentle expression. Clean reach of neck leading to well placed shoulders and good return of upper arm giving correct angulation in front. Good depth to forechest and ribs well sprung, firm through loin which meant she kept her topline at all times.

Good bend of stifle and well developed second thigh. In lovely coat and condition.

Moved very well in group but found the inside ring a little slippery so did not move as well for BIS therefore pleased to award her Best in Group and Reserve BIS.

1<sup>st</sup> Greenwoods Sandgold Happy to Know You (Golden Retriever)

Promising youngster built on strong lines. Masculine head with kind eye and good pigmentation. Powerful neck and good angulation for age. Deep forechest and ribs sprung and well back, well bent stifles and good muscle tone. Held a level topline throughout and moved very true to win the group.

BIS Dembiniok's Temelora Sun Dancer at Hollrexia SHCM – Papillon

This dog took my eye as he entered the ring, full of attitude and looked around the ring to ensure that I knew he was there. Good head and ear carriage, showing balance and style, neck flowed neatly into shoulders and level topline, Good angulation both front and rear, In beautiful coat of correct fine silky texture and well presented. When he moved it was true and he really covered the ground, a very smart dog.

Reserve BIS Hall's Gennara Lehana JW – Irish Setter

#### Best Puppy in Show

Foster & Gallaghers Turnstone Kameleon of Koppelwell – Whippet

I liked this young lady in BIS as she had also won the adult group but felt that she was just giving a little too much away in maturity. Feminine throughout but still had the required substance and power. Balanced and clean in outline portraying speed and elegance. Pleasing head and eye, good angulation both front and rear, deep through chest and firm through loin, in hard condition and moved with power covering the ground.

Reserve Best Puppy in Show

Bull & Warren's Starferry Rocket Man – Shar Pei

Short compact dog of good size and substance, Masculine head, broad and flat across skull. Powerful neck set neatly onto well placed shoulders, ribs well back and firm loin, moved with great poise and balance

#### Best Veteran in Show

Heim's Mayjo Benjamin at Brunita – Chow

Really liked this Chow and could not believe that he was 12yrs, Compact body, masculine head and super expression, good pigment throughout, in great condition and moved with typical stilted gait, a credit to his owners for the condition he was in.

Reserve Best Veteran in Show.

Malden's Jagers Wonder – Bull Terrier.

Another dog who is a credit to his owner for the hard and active condition this dog was in at 12. Masculine head with an intelligent expression. Powerful through neck and shoulders, well sprung rib and firm through loin, powerful quarters giving good drive on the move.
