Group 1 & Reserve Best Puppy In Show. was *Manchela Single Ladies* (Cocker Spaniel) bred and owned by Mr. M. Masters & Mr. M. F. Dott. A superbly balanced 10 month old girl who displayed plenty of animation whilst moving with power and drive. Shown in top condition and will I'm sure, go on to gain her title. **Group 2.** Went to Am. Ch. Rotojet Roll Call (IMP USA) (American Cocker Spaniel) handled by Ann Niessen. Another quality exhibit in excellent condition showing ring presence and moving well with drive. **Group 3.** *Magnavalley's Cornishman*, nicely balanced (Labrador Retriever) Owned by Mrs. Suzie J. & Mr. D. R. Kennett. **Group 4.** Went to a very mature (Golden Retriever) *Trewater Busy Lizzie at Balsamina* bred and shown by Miss Anneli Ives & Mr. T. Ives.

Dark pigmentation with balanced head and kindly expression, ample reach of neck, straight in forelegs tucked well under body, correct front angulation, gently sloping top line into well-turned stifles. A super outline with well-groomed coat, she moved extremely well, striding out covering plenty of ground.

Top quality boy with a mature balanced outline who was well-groomed and stood well. A balanced head and kindly expression with dark pigmentation, ample reach of neck leading into a gently sloping top line. Straight in forelegs tucked well under deep brisket, correct front angulation, well-turned but not too over angled hind quarters allowing full freedom of movement. Handled and moved well, striding out covering plenty of ground.

With Polmennor (IMP HUN)

Again, another well-presented exhibit, nicely balanced but who I felt lacked the front angulation and substance of 1. Moved and handled well.

Balanced bitch that stood and showed well, super outline with a coat in good bloom, lovely head and kindly expression displaying good pigmentation. Ample reach of neck with straight forelegs tucked well under the body and exuding correct front angulations. With a gentle sloping top line into well-turned rear quarters, she moved extremely well, striding out and covering plenty of ground.

RESERVE BEST OF BREED

2. W & D Bridgwater *Blazing Bronze Eye Candy (IMP NLD)*

A very nice bitch that was handled and moved well, but lacked the extra sparkle of 1.

Nicely balanced dog who stood and showed well. A masculine head and kindly expression showing dark pigmentation, ample reach of neck, straight in forelegs tucked well under body, correct front angulations and level top line into well-turned rear quarters. A super outline, with coat in full bloom and body well-muscled, he moved extremely well by striding out covering plenty of ground.

Another quality exhibit which I liked a lot, but didn't maintain a top line on the move and I felt movement was a little loose. Otherwise very nicely put together.

Well balanced and clean cut bitch of 10 months who caught my eye immediately. She stood and showed well for one so young with a lovely head and kindly expression displaying good dark pigmentation. Ample reach of neck, forelegs straight, with tight cat like feet and tucked well under the body displaying correct front angulations. A level top line leading to well-turned rear quarters which completed a super outline, and with her coat at its very best she moved with confidence and purpose, head held high, striding out with drive covering plenty of ground.

Balanced boy that stood and showed well for one so young, dark pigmentation with lovely head and kindly expression. Ample reach of neck, straight in forelegs tucked well under body with tight cat like feet, correct front angulation, level top line into well-turned rear-quarters. A super outline, he moved extremely well by striding out and covering plenty of ground.

RESERVE BEST OF BREED

2. Mr. & Mrs. F. W. & L. D. Cooves *Pajanbeck I Have A Dream
by Draketor*

Pleasing head and expression with length to neck and straight in foreleg, but I would have liked to have seen a little more angulations and substance in the rear quarters. He also failed to hold a level top line both stationary and on the move.

OPEN (5. 2):

My first two places both displayed the characteristics of a typical flatcoat, and all dogs excelled in type and confirmation. My winner, an alert bitch with pleasing head and expression, length to neck, straight in foreleg tucked well under deep chest, had tight feet, a level top line and strong well-angulated rear quarters. She moved soundly and with drive covering plenty of ground.

Another quality exhibit, a boy I liked very much. He showed a lot of personality and was nicely balanced. Everything I said for my first place would apply here, but just preferred my winner's overall lines both standing and on the move.

A super outline with her coat in full bloom, she moved extremely well striding out and covering the ground well for one so young.

A super outline, she moved with drive and maintained poise throughout. She strode forward well covering plenty of ground.

A balanced and mature boy that was nicely handled. Moved straight and true from the hock and covered plenty of ground. With a clean cut head held high, he maintained a balanced stance whilst on the move, showing a nicely arched neck into well laid shoulders, strong back and rear quarters. In good coat and muscular condition he pushed hard for BOB.

Correct front angulation, level top line into well-turned stifles, a super overall outline with coat in full bloom. She moved extremely well by striding out and covering the ring well.

A dog that just couldn't keep still long enough to properly examine him, but did feel he lacked a little substance in the rear quarters.
