Grad. – 4(1)a

1st – Dicker's - Moretonia Golden Girl at Neerodan.

Appealing young girl of good height & length, face & head of correct dimensions & showing nice dark eye colour, straight front with depth of chest & tight feet, moved with precise quick stepping action, shown in good clean tight coat.

2nd – Wills - Moretonia Easter Bonnet at Marlinett.

Female with length of muzzle in good context to eye placement & head shape, slender neck of correct length going onto well placed shoulders, correct length of body, good bend of stifle, stood well up on her toes, moved with nice animation.

3rd - Moretonia Jade in June.

Open. – 2(0)a

1st – Dicker's - Neerodan Made To Make It.

Male with strong masculine features & well accentuated markings, ample width of chest & correct shoulder placement, nice spring of rib & tuck up of loin, defined muscle on rear quarters & legs well spaced apart, tight rear feet & defined hocks, moved best overall with a sound true action & swiftness around the ring, presented & shown in lovely clean clear coat & handled well. BoB.

2nd – Warran's - Peclatro The World Is Mine.

Boy of good maturity & development for age, good dentition & strong jaw, muzzle of good length, correct eye shape & colour, length of neck & body of correct proportions & dimensions to height at withers, tail coming of the back nicely & carried well on the move.

Puppy. – 4(1)a

1st – Cox's - Fujairah Eric Morecambe.

6mth young Blenheim boy with nice balanced head & features, ears carried well with good length of leathers for age, body development showing sound conformation for a youngster & correct amount of bone on the leg, showed off a balanced & defined outline when viewed in profile with even coat markings that was pleasing to the eye, moved with good speed & even tracking fore & aft & was presented in clean coat still growing but with nice amount of feathering, well deserved his puppy group placing. Bp.

2nd – Franks - Cathmead Cheridah.

7mth Blenheim female with charming feminine appeal, face & head of nice development & shape, length of neck & body in correct context & tail flowing off her back well, topline not quite as strong as 1st place at this stage though, movement was with a sound balanced action & good length of stride, shown in good clean coat with striking rich Blenheim markings & nice amount of feathering.

3rd - Stansbury's - Cathmead Brian Boru at Doorclare.

Sp. Yearling. - 7(3)a

1st – Darlington's - Featherfalls Sacred Night.

Appealing young B/tan male with nicely developed masculine head for age, full round jet black nose with wide open nostrils & accentuated stop, ears & leathers of nice length framing the face well, body of good substance & development for age & showing best outline & topline in the class today, moved evenly front &

back with good amount of reach from the shoulder, cleanly presented & well handled.

2nd – Walton's - Jolainey Tinkerbelle With Underknoll.

Dainty feminine blenheim girl coming into her own, kind dark eyes & sweet expression, correct amount of dome on head with ears placed nicely apart giving a balanced view, length of body in proportion to height & tail coming off the back carried on the move well, presented in immaculately clean coat with rich markings & handled with sympathy.

3rd - Franks - Cathmead Here Comes Summer.

P. Grad. – 5(0)a

1st – Thompson's - Karaime's Golden Charm for Culverwood.

Ruby male of good size & development, good eye & ear placement with eyes of correct colour for coat, developed forechest with ample width between front legs, elbows tight in to shoulders, front legs well placed under body with feet facing forwards at all times, moved with nice animation & a steady gait, presented in lovely full coat clean & of a rich ruby colour.

2nd – Hawkings - Pendrailier Penomenal.

Blenheim male of nice maturity for age with defined head & facial features, lovely jet black fully made up nose & well defined stop, body of good height to the withers, tight elbows & correct lay of shoulder, nice tuck up of loin, movement all round was straight & true & without any degree of convergence at rear, shown in good clean coat & coat colour & handled well.

3rd - Yeates - Merryanna Easter Buddy.

Open dog. – 6(2)a

1st – Player's - Granasil Piccolo at Anickily.

My star of the show today, lovely example of a male ruby, masculine head with correct amount of dome in good proportion to neck & body length, ears & leathers set well on head & with just the right amount of length & feathering, body of good substance & development in all departments, this boy shows a true definition of the male standard, movement was as good as it can be showing fitness & freedom of reach with driving action from the rear, immaculately presented in fully mature ruby coat & handled letting him take the initiative, now doubt about him taking the group today. BoB.

2nd – Darlington's - Royal Fantasy Sacred Sunset of Featherfalls.

Another nice ruby male of good maturity & sound construction, height & length of body all in balanced proportions, of good substance & muscletone throughout, strong topline & tail flowing off the back nicely, well accentuated bend of stifle & defined hocks, moved with nice steady pace & evenness, as with all the exhibitors in this breed today was presented & shown in lovely coat & condition.

3rd - Wawman's - Bellrise Lil Boy Blue.

Open bitch. – 7(3)a

1st – Walton's - Underknoll Flamenco.

Tricolour girl of nice development & growth, feminine head not overdone but of correct balance & context making a lovely picture when viewed from the front, good construction of front & rear quarters with nice amount of bone & muscle, movement was sound & precise with good even tracking fore & aft.

2nd – Cox's - Magiro Snow Princess Fujairah

Sweet feminine girl with lots of appealing qualities about her, head of good shape with ears framing her face beautifully, nice spring of rib & tuck up of loin, tail flowing off her back & carried nicely, moved with a good turn of speed & showing confidence, turned out in full clean coat & profusely furnished.

3rd - Darlington's - Featherfalls Hayleys Comet.

Chihuahua. (S/C).

Grad. – 5(0)a

1st – Bannister's - Stanghurst Robin Goodfella.

Male of nice quality & construction, head of correct shape & size in proportion to body, ears erect & showing good alertness, good amount of spacing between front & rear legs which he held both standing & moving, showed out a nice clear outline & moved with a true even action & positive gait. BoB.

2nd – Whitton's - Mikichi Mirror Beau in Chinatown.

Another nicely developed male for age with pleasing face & expression, jet black nose fully made up & with open nostrils, correct dentition, defined stop & eyes large round & dark, neck & length of body in good context with tail position correctly, projected a nice outline both when standing & on the move.

3rd - Morris's - Kismeldon Master Marius.

Open. – 4(1)a

1st – Aylett's - Creddys Irrestable Me at Angcherish.

Girl of good development & femininity, pleasing eye & expression, skull showing nice width between ears with ears erect & alert, overall length & height of correct dimensions showing best outline in class, well developed rear quarters showing defined muscle & angulation, moved with soundness & a positive action.

2nd – Morris's - Mikichi Mirror Belle.

Sturdy young female with nice square front & even width between legs, strong bone going down to tight forward facing feet, nice development of body showing good conformation, well accentuated bend of stifle at rear, moved with animation & evenness, presented & shown in lovely coat condition.

3rd - Whitton's - Chinatown Charlie's Angel.

Chihuahua. (L/C).

Grad. – 4(0)a

1st – Lewis's - Tyssul Awel Y Mynydd.

Young male of correct development for age, good depth of chest, width of front & tight elbows, length of body in correct context to height, good tuck up of loin, front legs well placed under body, tail carried well over back when moving, coat covering body well & showing defined ruff & feathering.

2nd – Bardsley's - Hollyel Topaz Star.

Another young boy well built for age, pleasing masculine head, face showing good length of muzzle & defined stop, ears of correct shape & carried well, good bend of stifle & well laid back hocks, topline held nicely when moving, presented in clean full coat & covered profusely.

3rd - Skinner's - Mujeresa Peaky Blinder.

Open. – 5(0)a

1st – Radford's - Ridge hawk Treasure Girl.

Mature female example of the breed with lots to like about her, well developed & constructed all round, really upstanding in stature showing off a strong level topline & outline well, moved with good evenness front & back extending herself to cover the ring effortlessly, shown in lovely full mature coat & handled with minimal fuss. BoB.

2nd – Bardsley's - Hollyel Diamonds R Forever.

Male of good development & size, kind face & sweet expression, large round dark eye, full round nose with open nostrils, muzzle of correct proportion & well defined stop, of sound construction all round, moved with a steady controlled gait & showing a nice outline, turned out in full clean coat with full furnishing, well handled & presented.

3rd - Bardsley's - Hollyel Topaz Moon.

Grad. – 3(0)a

1st – Jackman's - Reubicia Cream Bow.

Cracking young male, neat & compact with short coupled body of good substance & conformation, correct mouth & bite, even legs & tight round feet facing forwards & well up on his toes, profuse orange coat of correct texture, lively mover who covered the ground with ease & determination, well deserved his group award. BoB.

2nd – Reid's - Pomirosa Special One.

Boy of good development, typical Spitz expression & well filled out face, straight front with neat tight feet & standing well up on his toes at rear, compact body well filled out & well covered in profuse coat, moved with good animation & speed.

3rd - French's - Norvanic Treacle Tart.

Open. – 4(0)a

1st – French's - Norvanic Happy Go Lucky.

Girl of good maturity for age, nice feminine foxy expression with facial features all in correct context, body of good construction & development, nice even space between rear legs which was kept when moving, shown in lovely clean full coat & handled superbly.

2nd – Lovell's - Shlarra Meet The Legend.

Young girl very alert & vivacious, cheeky face showing well defined stop, nice length of neck, feminine head, well developed forefront, compact body, good taper of leg with tight feet facing forwards well when stood, sound & precise on the move, just lacked coat today.

3rd - Jackman's - Sweet Pich Dancing Martin at Reubicia

P. Grad. – 2(0)a

1st – Lock's - Konishiki Willows Lad.

7mth young hairless boy with lots of virtues, good length of muzzle, correct dentition, ears carried up & held well on head, streamlined neck & body with deep chest & short loin, strong level topline with tail coming off back well, best all round movement in class.

2nd – Snell's - Anadeia Rain Dance.

Another young hairless male, this one of 11mths just starting to come into his own, good head shape in context with neck & body, good bend of stifle & developing second thigh, moved with plenty of animation & determination.

1st – Orchard's - Panspayon Eye Of The Storm.

Young b/white male, full of expression & character, shows good potential, developing a nice masculinity about him, correct eye & ear placement, body of good height & length ratio, legs & feet placed well under body & straight facing, profuse tail carried well over his back at all times, moved with a good extended length of stride & used the ring to gain best advantage. BoB.

2nd – Stanbury & Langdon's - Zkyvana Zero Hour For Inixia.

Tri-coloured boy of 11mths with lovely striking markings, developing well for age, endearing face & sweet expression showing good facial features, correct harefeet well placed, stands well & moved with good animation, shown in well furnished clean coat & handled nicely. Bp.

1st – Orchard's - Ringland Yoko's Solo At Panspayon. Sh Cm.

Attractive tri girl with good feminine head & lovely eye colour, deep chest, correct length of leg in proportion to length of body, good width between rear legs, showed best topline & outline in class, covered the ground with a nice steady action & determined drive.

2nd – Malcolm's - Feorlig It Must've Been Love.

Mature male with strong masculine head & expression, defined stop, well filled out muzzle & correct dentition, nice dark round kind eyes, ears well placed & carried up at all times, moved with good intent & purpose, shown in immaculate profuse clean tricoloured coat fully furnished all round.

3rd - Stanbury's - Inixia Ever Ready For Eddie. Sh Cm.

1st – Makepiece's - Sandigara Sweet Dreams.

Female of nice size & development, head & body of nice proportions not overdone at all, lovely facial make-up, good construction of front with ample width of chest, solid compact body, rear quarters well muscled with correct width between rear legs, moved with a good determined striding action, a nice youngster all round.

2nd – Crump's - Pigalle Pretty Wishes.

Lovely bitch with a nicely developed feminine head & good width of skull, compact body with good muscletone & tight waistline, front legs well under body, tightly curled tail, sound rear construction, stood four square & moved with purpose & drive.

3rd - Lee's - Glenalua Vishneva Tuckenhay.

Open. – 7(0)a

1st – Wills - Hugapug Penny Rose.

Nice female example of the breed, showed good balanced outline & conformity when standing & moving, make & shape all round was of nice development & to the standard, face & head in correct context with nothing overdone, moved with freedom & a good striding action & typical rolling gait, presented in tight clean coat of correct texture & handled well. BoB.

2nd – Makepiece's - Sandigara Second Thoughts.

Solid boy with correct head & ears, nice facial masking & shading, strong well laid back shoulders, good depth & width of chest, body of sound construction & well defined muscle, good curl of tail over back, he moved with a free gait & steady true action.

3rd - Lee's - Glenalua I'm Meryl Tuckenhay. Sh Cm.

Open. – 2(0)a

1st – Allen, Smith & Rees's - Tinolucianna Red Velvet With Telidor.

Red girl of nice quality & stature, good length of muzzle & well placed facial features, clean neck flowing into correct shoulder placement, nigh on faultless topline & outline, strong & well muscled all round, stormed around the ring with a very sound positive action using good initiative & making the most of it, well deserved her group placing. BoB.

2nd – Allen, Smith & Rees's - Telidor Thumbs Up With Tinolucianna.

Black & tan boy of correct size , square in outline, deep chest, good bend of stifle, extrovert & outgoing, moved with a sense of purpose & determination,viewed from the side showed a lovely hackneyed action that was not overdone, he never stopped showing, handled with care & cleanly presented.

Grad. – 2(1)a

1st – Osborne's - Magstarai Magic In The Stars.

Nicely mature girl full of character with attractive feminine face & head, strong neck going into nice lay of shoulder, defined withers, showed a nice outline with a good tailset & tail held well over her back, fore & rear quarters were well developed & with nice amount of muscle, good length of leg with plenty of bone, moving around she had good reach & showed off an excellent striding action, handling & presentation was superb, was very certain of her group place. BoB.

Open. – 2(0)a

1st – Shorter's - Sh Ch. Flyero's Devil In Disguise. Sh Cm.

Fully grown boy with good head shape & wonderful expression, lovely dark well placed eyes, strong bone, nice feet & nails, developed forechest with plenty of width between legs, moved with a fair turn of speed & drive around the ring, very well groomed & handled.

2nd – Osborne's - Magstarai Secrets Of The Sea.

Female with a lovely personality, feminine & dainty, has everything in good proportion, compact body of good height & length, well muscled all round, showed a nice outline in profile, very animated & enthusiastic on the move, nicely handled & presented in good clean coat & trim.

2nd – Thompson's - Rossyn Magical Fantasy For Culverwood. (Jap Chin)

9mth young b/w male with typical chin face & expression, ears well placed & of nice length, head & body of good development for age though slightly up on the leg but yet to settle to size, very lively & animated standing & on the move, no doubt about his puppy grp placing though. Best a.v.n.s.c Puppy.

3rd - Speight's - Bonniroy Yuzana. (Jap Chin)

1st – Speight's - Bonniroy Yumiko Aka. (Jap Chin)

Fully grown mature r/w girl having nice dainty feminine face & features, length of back in proportion to height from ground to withers, good tail carriage, nice spring of rib, good turn of stifle, moved best in class, turned out in immaculate clean red & white coat & full feathering & showing a lovely example of harefeet.

2nd – Tiley - Davies - Toerag Little Sunbeam. (It. Greyhound)

Mature girl coming on nicely with feminine face & defined head, clean neckline of good length in relation to body, deep chest & nice lay of shoulder, even rear legs, correct feet, moved with fair speed & purpose.
