Retriever – Labrador

Puppy (4)

1. Wallace's Dreammake Fot Tiaja (IMP POL) - young yellow bitch with a feminine head, neck muscular and clean, forequarters straight with good bone, deep chest, good spring of rib, angles correct front and rear moved well. BP
2. Findjan's Cremino Capability Rossacre - 8 month old yellow dog with broad skull, clean strong neck into well laid back shoulders, forequarters straight with good bone, enough depth of chest with well sprung ribs. Not the front movement of the first or the maturity.
3. Wood's Mollenby Midnight Beauty

Graduate (4,2)

1. Kennett & Kennett's Magnavalleys Over The Moon – black 17 month old male with broad skull, clean strong neck into well laid back shoulders, forequarters straight with good bone, enough depth of chest with well sprung ribs. Moved well when he settled.
2. Findjan's Magnavalleys Moon Light Rossacre – litter sister to the first, not overdone in any way, a balanced picture when stacked, showing correct angulation front and back with hocks well let down, super otter tail, however she never really settled on the move.

Limit (6,4)

1. Mills & Mills' Jaybec Winter Wispa - young bitch not overdone in any way, a balanced picture when stacked, showing correct angulation front and back with hocks well let down, super otter tail which he used to good effect on the move.
2. Fishlock's Carpenny Halshimoor Delicious – bitch presenting a clean outline, longer in body than first, kind and alert expression, balance head, muscular neck into well laid back shoulders, chest of sufficient depth, straight front with good bone. Moved well.
3. Kennett & Kennett's Magnavalleys Moon Dance

Open ((5,4)

1. Kennett & Kennett's Magnavalleys Trebah - bitch exceling in breed type, broad head with kind expression, thick coat with dense undercoat, super temperament and thick otter tail. Deep chest, barrel ribbed and short coupled, angles correct front and rear

with hocks well let down. Moved well covering the ground and straight front and rear. BOB

2. Mills & Mills' Trendlewood Day Dreaming - bitch unlucky to meet first today and did not move as freely. Kind feminine head, muscular neck into well laid back shoulders, straight front with sufficient bone, deep chest and short coupled.
3. Jeffery's Lembas Swings Both Ways at Mibridge

Open (1)

1. Kibby's Trimere Taylor Maid at Pinhays JW - Liver/white bitch who was full of breed type, skull of the correct length, which was feminine with good chiselling and kind expression, good length to her neck, straight forelegs, stifles and hocks moderately bent, she moved effortlessly covering the ground and true from every angle. BOB

Beagle

Post Graduate (2)

1. Breeze & Breeze's Parkebreeway Wyseman JW – 2 year old tan and white mature dog, correct ear set, strong neck leading into well laid back shoulders and good level topline. Good turn of stifle, strong hocks used to move true front and back. BOB.
2. Breeze & Breeze's Dufosee Honestly of Parkebreeway - tri bitch head balanced with dark eye, pleasing outline, neck slightly arched and good lay of shoulders, well muscled hindquarters and angulation front and back correct. Moved well.

Open (1)

1. Breeze & Breeze's Davricard Hummingbird of Parkebreeway – 7 year old male deep head with a slight stop, dark eye, long, muscular neck, enough bone and good body coverage, well sprung ribcage, moderate angulation front and rear and moved soundly around the ring with good tail carriage.

Post Graduate (2.1)

1. Godber-Ford's Affyneeta Desert Wind - 3 year old dog presented in lovely condition, very attractive balanced masculine head, long lean neck, deep chest with good spring of rib, Moved effortlessly around the ring with super smooth, springy action and good head carriage. BOB

Open (2.1)

1. Godber-Ford's Affyneeta Mountain Breeze – litter brother to the Post Graduate winner, shown in excellent coat and condition. A balanced dog front and rear, he has a good depth of chest, good spring of rib, correct croup, well set tail not as enthusiastic as his sister on the move.

AV Graduate Stakes (30, 21)

1. Hipkiss' Afonbach First Sign O'Spring at Deltandamba JW NSDT Retriever – bitch who caught my eye when she entered the ring. Super type with an appealing head, shoulders well laid back, forelegs straight and strong, deep chest with well sprung ribs, level topline, good turn of stifle and hocks well let down, double coated and straight of medium length, moved with good reach and drive and correct head carriage.
2. Hirst's Sundark Scaramouche Sheltland SheepDog – blue merle bitch who was rather eyecatching. Presented so well. Pleasing outline and she stands over her ground easily. Balanced angulation front and rear. Very sound on the move.
