Cocker Spaniel

J (1,0)

1. Newstead's Alisma Annabelle – 14 mth Blue roan girl with a feminine head, clean neck, good lay of shoulder, well sprung ribcage, level topline and short loin. Pasterns could be stronger and coat was presented ok. Moved well enough and held her shape as she went.

G (2,0)

1. McCabe-Bell's Zheridons Zephyranthes At Grandtully – Golden girl, just lacking in coat and a bit of body. She has a pleasing head with good chiselling, clean neck into a good shoulder, I would just prefer slightly less length to her loin and a bit more hind angulation. She does move out well and certainly uses her tail as she goes.

2. Mason's Chavez Sunrise – Orange roan, plainer in head than the winner and she could have a better return of upper arm. However, she has a good topline and rear angulation and is straight away and back. Sadly, she wasn't enjoying her day and her tail was kept tucked under and she was rather unsettled on the table.

O (5,0)

1. McCabe-Bell's Grandtully Eliza Doolittle – I recently judged this girl and the same comments apply. Black bitch who is just so elegant and well presented. Square muzzle, distinct stop, dark eye, muscular neck, sloping shoulders, compact body and well rounded hindquarters. She moved out really well, using her tail as she went. - BOB

2. Dean's Sandlauga Sherbet Pip With Ttsabelli – A very elegant blue roan bitch, really liked her head, square muzzle with good detail, low set ears, muscular neck, sloping shoulders, topline could just relax a bit more but otherwise she is sound on the move and uses her tail well. Presented and handled well. - RBOB

Cesky Terrier

O (1,0)

1. Lewis' Komidion Rychnovsky Dajaces – Grey blue male, 3yo, skull slightly arched, large nostrils, high set ears, elegant neck, muscular shoulders, he has well arched loin and strong hindquarters. Moved briskly and soundly. BOB

Dachshund Mini S/H

G (4,1)

1. Wilkinson & Wakeham's Darque Angel For Wakywilks – Black/tan bitch, a lot to like about this girl, feminine head of a good shape, strong jaw, high set ears, long and muscular neck, shoulder blades were long, good length to the ribcage, her only issue was her topline as she does tend to roach it slightly when stood and on the move.

2. Wilkinson & Wakeham's Bronia Gabriel For Wakywilks – Same kennel as the class winner . Shaded red boy, 8 mth old, overall longer than the winner and not the strength in his hindquarters. Needs to relax into his topline as he was rather tense. Pleasing head shape and clean neck. Good forechest and depth to brisket. BPIB

3. Landry's Duchyroyal's Ocean Dawn

O (6,1)

1. Small's Sonorra Twinkle Star For Devondax – Shaded red girl, won the class and bob as she holds her shape well whether stacked or on the move. She is elegant, although I would prefer a touch more length to her neck. Sloping shoulder, good ribbing and muscular hindquarters. Moved very soundly. BOB

2. Wilkinson & Wakeham's Bronia Valentina For Walkywilks – Another lovely girl, black/tan, good outline and a level topline, well laid shoulder, filled in forechest with a prominent keel, enough bone. Just not as clean behind on the move as the winner.

3. Ashby's Midlandbulls Willow

Dachshund W/H

G (3,0)

1. Jackson's Elderkine Special Brew - Smart young male, long, conical shaped head, strong jaw, good length to his neck, sloping shoulders and elbows tucked in, enough ribbing, strong rump and parallel hindlegs. Moved well enough to win the class.– BOB

2. Effer's Kasalane Rhapsody – Another smart boy, slightly longer on leg than the winner, good head and long neck, enough ribbing and length to the loin, more moderate behind that 1. But he also held himself well on the move.

3. Effer's Cishivine Miss Tyfication

Ibizan Hound

OD (2,1)

1. Carter's Nevaeh's Radical Dude – Finely built male, long skull with a balanced muzzle, long and slightly arched neck, steep shoulder blades, good tuck up and long second thigh. Just a bit untidy on the move today.

OB (3,1)

1. Carter's Amahte's Bewitched – 10yo who won the class for her sound movement. Beautiful head and expression, long, slightly arched neck, short shoulder blades, level backed and long ribcage. She moved out well for her age. BOB

2. Carter's Ch Afilador Room On The Broom – 7yo girl who was really enjoying her day. Another super head with a dignified expression, long neck, steep shoulders, level backed with a slight slope to the croup. Moved well enough.

AVNSC Hound

G (5,3)

1. Turner's Devonhound Miracle Of Love – Basset Hound – BAVNSC & BAVNSC Puppy – What an eye catcher this bicolour puppy is. Masculine head with a moderate stop and lean foreface, low set ears, strong jaw, well laid shoulders, super bone and powerful forelegs, well sprung ribs, broad and level backed, muscular hindquarters and I couldn't fault him on the move. Delighted to hear he went RBPIS

2. Carter's Aabidah De Polvo Magico – Sloughi – A beautiful example of the breed but was just unsettled and not enjoying her day. She is elegant, long and refined skull, strong jaws, long neck leading to long shoulder blades, prominent sternum, well ribbed and short loin and moderate hind angulation. She moves so well with a free and easy stride.

O (6,3)

1. Way & Burley's Swansford Almadora – Dachs L/H – Red bitch who was a super example. Feminine head with a slightly arched skull, almond eyes, long, clean neck, long shoulder blades, good bone, short in loin and strong hindquarters, moved soundly in all directions and never lost her topline.

2. Turner's Devonhound Who's That Girl – Basset Hound – Litter sister to the winner of the previous class. Another quality hound, similar comments apply but I just preferred the movement behind of her brother. These two pups must have a bright future ahead of them.

3. Carter's Gouvier Espresso Martini – BFDB

Hound Group

1. Starks Adnerbs Won Vision Of Gobannium – Dachs S/H – Well balanced dog with a super outline and a topline that she never lost. Moved soundly away and back and reached well with her forelegs and showed drive from behind. Muscular and well boned but still feminine.

2. Devonhound Miracle Of Love

3. Breeze's Parkebreeaway Wyseman – Beagle – Smart looking male, with a masculine head, well flewed lips, long neck although this could be cleaner, well laid shoulders, enough bone, level topline, deep brisket, moderate hind angulation. Moved straight and showed drive.

4. Durante's Galemira's Pandora Of Duranridge – Whippet – Brindle bitch with white trim, elegant and curvy, beautiful head and alert expression, long clean neck, shoulders had enough lay back to them but I would prefer more length to her upper arm so the forelegs were underneath her body. Pasterns could have a touch more spring to them but she has good bone, a good spring of rib and moderate angulation behind. Moved out well enough.

Hound Puppy Group

1. Devonhound Miracle Of Love

2. Bronia Gabrial For Wakywilks

3. Durante's Duranridge Fire Stone – Whippet – Brindle male with white trim, built on plenty of bone and substance and wouldn't want any more of him, pleasing head, clean neck with a slight arch, well laid shoulder and straight forelegs, muscular hindquarters. Moved ok.

AV Hound

P (3,2)

1. Small's Kenzduo Mojito At Devondax – Dachs Mini L/H – One I have recently judged. Rather raw red bitch, however, she held her topline on the move, she carried her tail low and was sound away and back. Pleasing conical head, clean neck, elbows tucked in and a long ribcage.

O (7,4)

1. Prowse' Crosscop One Step Closer To Freehamlet – Whippet – Elegant fawn girl, a beautiful head with a kind expression, long muscular neck, well laid shoulder but just lacked length to her upper arm, excellent ribcage and depth to her brisket, good tuck up and a good turn to her stifle. Moved soundly.

2. Livsey's Bryntreia Sea Of Love – Whippet – Another whom I have recently judged but today he didn't have quite the same sparkle. Brindle male with a white trim, masculine head, clean neck into well laid shoulders. He has a flowing topline with a rise over the loin, a good tuck up, ideal turn of stifle and stands on good feet. Could be stronger in pastern. Moves well both away and back and in side profile.

3. Carter's Rangali Booty Licious – BFDB

V (5,1)

1. Tree's Ardenrun Sea Shanty By Keimantre – Dachs Mini S/H – Red bitch, looking so good for her age, she never lost her shape, held her tail low, has a pleasing head, good forechest and ribcage and shown in good condition.

2. Prowse' Supeta's Ice Ice Baby – Whippet – beautiful brindle lady, she is elegant and curvy, has a good ribcage, deep brisket, the desired arch over her loin, enough turn to her stifle and well arched knuckles. Moved soundly and was very light on her feet.

3. Ch Afilador Room On The Broom

Vintage (1,0)

1. Amahte's Bewitched – BVIG

Champion (2,0)

1. Breeze's Ch Dufosee Dragonfly Of Parkebreeway – Beagle – Super tri girl, a real quality dog, loved her head and expression, no coarseness, long and clean neck, well laid back shoulders and straight forelegs, straight topline and well sprung ribs, good turn of stifle and very sound in all directions.
